CODE OF CONDUCT

Revised and adopted 12/31/2018

The following code of conduct is required of all active members. A failure to comply with this code of conduct and the responsibilities therein is cause for membership suspension or termination.

Members will make every effort to respect the model railroad equipment owned by the Central Pasco and Gulf Railroad, Inc. and the equipment owned by other members. Members will not operate or handle privately owned locomotives without advance permission of the owner. Any rolling stock other than self-propelled locomotives on the track, whether owned privately or by members, may be operated with care and consideration by any active qualified member only following and having received the expressed permission and authority of the equipment owner. Specially designated storage tracks for personal equipment are off limits at any time without first securing the direct consent from the owner of the equipment.

- A. Members will always demonstrate behavior contributing to the successful mission and purpose of CPGRR, Inc. consistent with corporate bylaws, policies and procedures and this code of conduct.
- B. Participation in CP&GRR public runs, annual meets and special events is a condition for our use of the Crews Lake Park. Members are expected to participate in maintenance and projects, assist at the annual meets, and participate in CPGRR special events. Should an active member not be able to assist with the actual operations of the track during an event, that member is expected to assist with advance preparations for the event or post-event work requirements.
- C. Appropriate social and courteous behavior is expected of all active members always while at the track or when representing CPGRR to others. Any disagreement between two or more members should be handled privately and in a respectful professional manner. Any continuing conflict, disagreement, or personal issue between two or more members should be handled by those involved away from the CPGRR facility.
- D. Members will not lie, cheat or steal nor tolerate any member who does.
- E. All active members shall abide by the CP&GRR Operating Rules as specified in the CPGRR Operating Rules document.
- F. Members will make every effort to share the track with others in cases where several members wish to operate trains at the same time.
- G. No alterations to the track will be permitted without the authority of the Central Pasco and Gulf Railroad, Inc. Board of Directors.
- H. Any active or prospective member who alters the track or railroad facilities in any way without the explicit authorization of the CPGRR Board of Directors shall be held responsible for all required repairs or restorations, and/or payment for the alterations made.
- I. No weapons specifically designed to inflict bodily injury upon another human being shall be allowed within the CP&GRR facility. Members are asked to keep all such weapons in their vehicles while attending Membership meetings and functions at the railroad.
- J. No smoking of any kind is allowed within the buildings or car barns at any time.
- K. The last person to leave the facility at any time or event is responsible for shutting and locking the facility doors and turning off all lights and electrical power to the facility.
